
R4i Save Dongle Review



Ok, now this is an interesting piece of kit. It's a Save Dongle from the R4i Team! It allows you to back up game saves from your physical copies of games for 3DS and DS! For me, this is excellent because I constantly worry about losing my game saves so it essentially allows you to backup saves, and then put them on the card if you need them at a later date. But does it work? Is it easy to use? How's the quality? What is the meaning of life? I can answer all those questions except for the last.

Build Quality













The box it comes in looks like an R4i DS box but just with the "Save Dongle" written on it. This isn't necessarily a bad thing, but it would have been nice to see a slightly different design to differentiate but heck, it's not the box I am reviewing, it's the actual product, right? The dongle itself is very well made and the shell feels nice and fixed. I would have no worries about dropping this as it definitely won't break from that. It has a hole in the side of the unit where you can place original DS and 3DS carts. It protrudes slightly out of my laptop but this isn't really a big issue as you won't be keeping in there for long periods anyway.






How it works

Firstly, before you can transfer save files from your games to your computer, you will have to install some drivers. These are available on the site but is quite hard to find which frustrated me a little. Once you have installed the driver however and installed the program that will transfer the files, this tool is a joy to use. It automatically detects whether you have a 3DS cart in it or a DS cart in it and it's simply clicking what you want to do and watch the program quickly do it.



Simply click "Card -> PC" to open up the save screen where you can write the name of the save file and where to put it




Once you click save, the program runs and in seconds, your save file is backed up onto your PC or Laptop!







That's it. Done! To test if this actually worked I deleted my Super Mario 3D Land save file after backing it up (crazy, right?) and then put it back on from my Laptop to my game cart. Here are the results...







Now that it's deleted, I put my game cart back in the save dongle then choose the option "PC -> Card" from the program and open up the Super Mario 3D Land save file I backed up before.





Surely enough, it's back in all its glory! Works perfectly! The process was quick and painless also. So, overall, I would definitely recommend this piece of kit to anyone who is worried about their game saves or has a brother or sister who wants to play a game but there is only 1 save file. Time to give my final verdict.
